### Meeting overview

On the 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2022, the International Labour Organization, Walk Free, and International Organization for Migration released the new Global Estimates on Modern Slavery: Forced labour and forced marriage. These estimates provide valuable insights and impetus to the work of the private sector on eradication of forced labour. To present the latest figures as well as what these estimates mean for the private sector, the ILO Global Business Network on Forced Labour, the Employers Confederation of the Philippines (ECOP), and the Malaysian Employers Federation (MEF) will be undertaking an online briefing for their members and other interested companies and business representative organizations. The ILO GBNFL will also be releasing its report on Eradicating forced labour: What works in practice and this presentation will highlight key actions necessary for identifying, preventing and addressing the ILO's 11 indicators of forced labour.
